



# Supplemental Security Income



## What is Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for Children?

SSI benefits may be available for a child who meets the eligibility requirements of age, disability determination and deeming of family income and resources.

Disability determination is based on if the child has a medically determinable physical or mental impairment or impairments which result in marked and severe functional limitations; and the impairment(s) has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous period of at least 12 months or be expected to result in death; or the child is blind.

Once eligibility is determined, Medicaid is available in Arkansas for children who are determined to be eligible for SSI.
